The Mental Health Senior Counselor's responsibilities can be varied, but generally include the following:

- Review clinical documentation for regulatory compliance and feedback to children's clinic team
- Participation in agency multidisciplinary team meetings
- Provide various outpatient mental health services with the goal of patient recovery to children and their families
- Conduct intakes and provide individual, group, and family therapies
- Develop service plans and conduct reviews as required throughout the duration of treatment
- Provide mental health assessments, counseling, referrals, and intervention services
- Complete and maintain documentation according to federal and state guidelines.
- Part of a team on an interdisciplinary service delivery model
- Participate actively in weekly Supervision, Case Conference, and trainings
- Attend trainings as required to maintain licensure and certifications, as well as, gaining personal awareness
- Strong affinity for working with children, adolescents, and families
